### I.3. Registration

Online registration only. There will be on-site registration at Thursday, 7 August 2025, until 16.00 WIB (UTC+7) On site payment will be available in cash only.

Normal Payment **Rp300.000,00** And **USD 25.00** foreigner rider Onsite

Entry fees are non-refundable.

## I.4. Licenses

- I.4.1. All Riders including Master and Youth racers must have a valid ICF/UCI license.
- I.4.2. For others, Please refer to the Category Charts in your discipline to see what Category you are eligible for with the license you have.
- I.4.3. If your National category is Elite, you cannot race as a Master and vice versa.
- I.4.4. The categories are defined as per UCI rules based on year of birth. Racing age for the Championship is the rider's age as of on December 31, 2025.

## I.5. Warm-Up / Pre-Riding the Course

- I.5.1. Warming up on the course while a race is in progress, or at any other unauthorized time, is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification.
- I.5.2. Please respect the other racers by not warming up immediately behind the last place rider in the on going race.
- I.5.3. Helmets and plate number must be worn at ALL TIMES when riding in the course & failure to comply will result in disqualification.

## I.6. Race Numbers and Timing

- I.6.1. Race numbers will be distributed at sign-in/plate pickup
- I.6.2. FTZ ID will be distributed at sign-in/plate pickup
- I.6.3. Transponder will be distributed at sign-in/plate pickup
- I.6.4. Transponder must be installed, Rider who do not have a transponder installed are declared DNS
- I.6.5. Transponder must be return after final race. If you lose it or don't return it you will be subject to a fine Rp.1.500.000,- or \$100,-
- I.6.6. Race will be timed by timing company recommended by ICF.
- I.6.7. Plates MUST be mounted on the handle bars and clearly visible.
- I.6.8. Numbers cannot be cut, folded or modified and must clearly show all advertising. Any infringements, penalty of Rp200.000,00 is applied.

## II. Race Detail

### II.1. Categories

Men Elite	aged 19 and above
Women Elite	aged 19 and above
Men Junior	17 and 18 years
Women Junior	17 and 18 years
Men Youth	14 to 16 years (a parent or legal guardian must sign on their behalf.)
Women Youth	14 to 16 years (a parent or legal guardian must sign on their behalf.)
Men Master A	30 to 39 years
Men Master B	40 and above
Women Master	30 and above

- II.2. Athletes may only enter in the course, both for training and competition, with their number plate and helmet. Riders found training without these items may be fined by the Commissaires' Panel.
- II.3. For the event, the athlete must carry his number plate on the handlebars and his dorsal number on the back, at the height of the jersey pocket.
- II.4. Plate numbers cannot be cut or altered.
- II.5. Athletes who train outside the time established for their category may be penalized DQ.
- II.6. The athlete must start with the jersey of his/her Team-Club-Sponsor. It cannot be sleeveless. If a raincoat is used, it must be transparent.
- II.7. Only those carrying an identification, ID Card will enter the feed/technical assistance area, which will be distributed when picking up kits.
- II.8. Feed and technical assistance are only allowed in designated areas. Glasses exchanges must take place at the same location.
- II.9. Contact between supporter and athlete will only be allowed in the Feed/technical assistance zones. It is not allowed to throw water on the athlete or the bicycle.
- II.10. The manager must not run through the entire feed zone alongside the athlete to supply.
- II.11. Food must be passed from hand to hand. Bicycle exchange is not allowed.
- II.12. Athletes who go out the course during the race for any reason must return to the course from the same point where they left off.
- II.13. The Appeals will be accepted up to 15 minutes after the final result of the category.
- II.14. The event will be governed by this technical guide, the NF regulations and the UCI rules.
- II.15. Cases not covered by this technical guide will be judged by the Commissaires' Panel. Their decisions will be final and no appeal against it will be accepted.
- II.16. Riders will be called to the start no earlier than 10 minutes before the scheduled start of the race.
- II.17. Five minutes before a call-up an announcement will be made over the public address system to inform riders of the fact, and again three minutes beforehand.
- II.18. The riders line up in the order in which they are to be called to the start line. The number of riders on each line is decided by the president of the commissaires' panel and supervised by a commissaire. The rider himself decides which position on the line to take.
- II.19. Once the riders are lined up, warm-up (by rollers, turbo trainer, etc.) is excluded inside or outside the start area.
- II.20. The start is given by the start commissaire using the following procedure: warnings 3, 2, 1 minutes and 30 seconds before the start, then a final announcement that the start is given within the next 15 seconds. A whistle will be given to indicate the start.
- II.21. The start commissaire is in sole control of the public address system from three minutes before the start, until the start has been given.
- II.22. Categories with fewer than 4 starters may be merged with another age or ability category at the discretion of the Chief Commissaires for the start, but will receive result separately.
- II.23. Racing format may also be modified at the discretion of the President of the Commissaires Panel in response to prolonged stoppages.

**III. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

### III.1. Results

- III.1.1. As soon as the timing company presents the final results of each category, it will be announced and posted. An Appeal will be accepted during the race or up to 15 minutes after the result is announced.
- III.1.2. After this period, the result will be approved by the Organization and published as official. Only written appeal will be accepted.
- III.1.3. The Appeals will be accepted up to 15 minutes after the final result of the category.

### III.2. Podium

- III.2.1. All athletes who have placed on the podium must attend the awards ceremonies. Failure to do so will result in a fine and loss of award (including prize money).
- III.2.2. Riders who cannot attend the awards ceremony must advise the Chief Commissaire Panel and the Technical Delegate with a valid reason. Reasons such as, "I have a flight to catch" will not be accepted.
- III.2.3. Riders must wear cycling apparel to the awards ceremony. Failure to do so will result in a fine and loss of award (including prize money).
- III.2.4. Riders must present themselves properly and must wear their racing attire and shoes. Riders No 1 may take their bike on the podium.

### III.3. Waivers

For riders under 17 years of age, a parent or legal guardian must sign on their behalf.

### III.4. Pits

- III.4.1. There will be limited Pit Space.
- III.4.2. Riders can book space for their pits by WhatsApp at +62 818-1840-1176
- III.4.3. Organizer will open and close the pit reservation period at the same time as the rider registration period.
- III.4.4. The venue manager has full rights over the arrangement of participant tents in the venue. All tent construction must be with the knowledge of the venue manager.
- III.4.5. Setting up tents for participants can be done from Thursday at 08.00 to 16.00. Anyone who sets up a tent outside these hours must comply if the venue manager asks to move their tent. Especially for those who haven't made a booking beforehand
- III.4.6. Tents must be 3m x 3m and all 4 legs must be weighted down.
- III.4.7. Vehicles Not be able to remain near the pits.
- III.4.8. Unloading maximum at 07:00 am outside these hours all vehicles except with special permission are required to leave the area.

### III.5. ELIGIBILITY

- III.5.1. Proof of ID maybe required (this includes driver's license, permanent resident card).
- III.5.2. All participants must be prepared to present their license up on demand at the event. License must be presented during race package pick-up
- III.5.3. Athletes are not considered registered for an event until all administrative requirements have been full filled.
- III.5.4. Complete the application form through website


- III.5.5. Sign the waiver for safety and health risk.
- III.5.6. Riders license has been validated by the designated commissaire.
- III.5.7. All riders and participants must to act and behave sportive and obey any orders by commissaire or race officials.
- III.5.8. No Alcohol can be used in the venue, any violation of this will result on expelling from the venue.
- III.5.9. No gambling of the sport

### III.6. First Aid and Medical

- III.6.1. Medical problems should be reported to a commissaire. The event(s) will be run under ICF/UCI rules and specific regulation of 76 Indonesian XC 2025.
- III.6.2. Dedicated medical staff will be in place during the event. Patrol will be at the start for all Closed Course Training, Seeding and Race Runs. The area is served by 118 service
